Second: HEARING

2 Timothy 4:3-4 (NASB) “For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but wanting to have their ears tickled, they will accumulate for themselves teachers in accordance to their own desires, and will turn away their ears from the truth and will turn aside to myths.”

1 Kings 3:9 (NASB) “So give Your servant an understanding heart (*leb shama*) to judge Your people to discern between good and evil.”

Third: DOING

Luke 6:47 (NASB) “Everyone who comes to Me and hears My words and acts on them.”

John 8:31-32 (NASB) “If you continue in My word, then you are truly disciples of Mine; and you will know the truth, and the truth will make you free.”
