

James 4:6-10 (NASB) "But He gives a greater grace. Therefore it says, "God is opposed to the proud, but gives grace to the humble." Submit therefore to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded. Be miserable and mourn and weep; let your laughter be turned into mourning and your joy to gloom. Humble yourselves in the presence of the Lord, and He will exalt you."

**First: SURRENDER to God.**

James 4:7 "Submit therefore to God."

*Submission is a military term meaning, "to place ones self in their proper rank."*

James 4:7 "Resist the devil and he will flee from you."

Matthew 4:1-11

**1. Jesus SURRENDERED Himself to God.**

Matthew 4:1 (NASB) "Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil."

**2. Jesus HUMBLED Himself and drew near to God.**

Matthew 4:2 (NASB) "He fasted forty days and forty nights."

**3. Jesus RESISTED the Devil.**

(See: Matthew 4 verses 4,7, and 10).

John 15:7 (NASB) "I you abide in Me, and my words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it shall be done for you."

**Second: DRAW NEAR to God:**

James 4:8 (NASB) "Draw near to God and he will draw near to you."

**1. You need to learn to ABIDE in Christ:**

John 15:5 (NASB) "I am the vine you are the branches; he who abides in me and I in him, he bears much fruit; for apart from Me you can do nothing."

**2. Deal seriously with SIN:**

James 4:8b (NASB) "Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double minded."

1 John 1:9 (NASB) "If we confess our sin He is faithful and just to forgive us our sin and cleanse us of all unrighteousness."

Acts 3:19 (NASB) "Repent therefore and return, that your sins may be wiped away, in order that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord."

**3. Dwell in His Word:**

John 18:31-32 (NKJV) "If you continue in My Word then you are my disciples indeed and you shall know the truth and the truth will set you free."

2 Timothy 4:2 (NASB) "Be diligent to present yourself approved to God as a workman who does not need to be ashamed, handling accurately the word of truth."

Ephesians 6: 17b (NASB) "(And take up) the sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God."

How then should we live?

**1. Learn to PRAY in faith:**

1 John 5:14-15 "This is the confidence which we have before Him, that, if we ask anything according to His will, he hears us. And if we know that He hears us in whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests which we have asked from Him."

**2. Walk in OBEDIANCE:**

John 15:10 (NASB) "If you keep My commandments, you will abide in my love; just as I have kept My Father's commandments, and abide in His love."

➤ **FELLOWSHIP with other believers:**

John 13:34-35 (NASB) "A new commandment I give unto you that you love one another as I have loved you that you also love one another. By this shall all men know you are my disciples that you have love one for the other."

Hebrew 10; 24-25a (NASB) "Let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds, not forsaking our own assembling together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another; and all the more as you see the day drawing near."

➤ **WITNESS to the lost world:**

Matthew 28:18-20 (NASB) "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. God therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

Acts 1:8 (NASB) "You shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth."
