

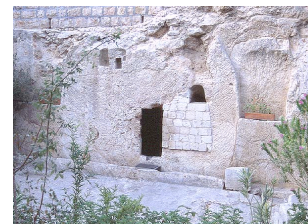
**First: The ADVENT of Supernatural Faith.**

Romans 10:17 (NASB) "So faith comes from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ."

Ephesians 2:8-9 "For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of ourselves, it is the gift of God; not as a result of works, that no one should boast."

John 6:44 (NASB) "No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him; and I will raise him up on the last day."

Romans 5:6-8 (NASB) "For while we were still helpless, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly. For one will hardly die for a righteous man; though perhaps for the good man someone would dare even to die. But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us."



**The PROCLAMATION of the Gospel:**

Philippians 1:17 (NASB) "The former proclaim Christ out of selfish ambition, rather than from pure motives, thinking to cause me distress in my imprisonment. What then? Only that in every way, whether in pretense or in truth, Christ is proclaimed; and in this I rejoice, yes, and I will rejoice."

**Christ must be preached!!!!**

**The HEARING of the Gospel:**

Romans 10:17 (NASB) "So faith comes from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ."

**Second: There is the ACTIVITY of a supernatural faith.**

Romans 10:17 (NASB) "So faith comes from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ."

**First it LEVELS the playing field:**

Romans 10:11-13 (NASB) "For the Scripture says, 'Whoever believes in Him will not be disappointed. For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek; for the same Lord is Lord of all, abounding in riches for all who call on Him; for Whoever will call on the name of the Lord will be saved.'"

**Second it LEADS everyone to the Christ of the Gospel:**

Romans 10:8-9 (NASB) "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart"—that is, the word of faith which we are preaching, that if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved."

Acts 4:12 (NASB) "Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved."

**Third: The AFFIRMATION of a supernatural faith.**

Romans 10:17 (NASB) "So faith comes from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ."

Romans 10: 9-10 (NASB) "That if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you shall be saved; for with the heart man believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he confesses resulting in salvation."

**Confessing Christ as SAVIOR:**

Romans 10:11 (NASB) "The Scripture says, 'Whoever believes in Him will not be disappointed.'"

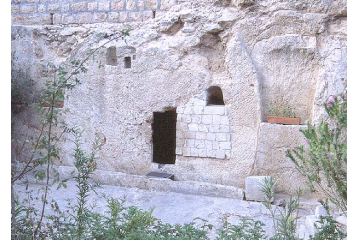
Romans 1:16 (NASB) "I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believes; to the Jew first and also to the Greek."

Romans 1:14-15 (NASB) "I am under obligation both to Greeks and to barbarians, both to the wise and to the foolish. So, for my part, I am eager to preach the gospel to you also who are in Rome."

Supernatural Faith  
Romans 10:11-17

2 Timothy 1:8-9 (NASB) "Therefore do not be ashamed of the testimony of our Lord or of me His prisoner, but join with me in suffering for the gospel according to the power of God, who has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was granted us in Christ Jesus from all eternity."

Matthew 10:32-33 (NASB) "Therefore everyone who confesses Me before men, I will also confess him before My Father who is in heaven. But whoever denies Me before men, I will also deny him before My Father who is in heaven."



**Confessing Christ as SOVEREIGN:**

Roman 10:9 (NASB) "If you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord and believe in your heart that God has raised him from the dead, you shall be saved."

1 Corinthians 12:3 (NASB) "No man can say Jesus is Lord, but by the Holy Spirit"

**The NATURAL Man:**

1 Corinthians 2:14 (NASB) "A natural man does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; and he cannot understand them, because they are spiritually appraised."

**The SPIRITUAL Man:**

1 Corinthians 2:15-16 (NASB) "But he who is spiritual appraises all things, yet he himself is appraised by no one. For who has known the mind of the Lord, that he will instruct Him? But we have the mind of Christ."

**The CARNAL Man:**

1 Corinthians 3:1-3a (NASB) "Brethren, could not speak to you as to spiritual men, but as to carnal men, as to infants in Christ. I gave you milk to drink, not solid food; for you were not yet able to receive it. Indeed, even now you are not yet able, for you are still carnal."
