Hebrews 9:27 (NASB) “It is appointed for each man to die once and after this comes judgment.”

**First: What does Jesus SAY about Judgement?**

Matthew 25:31-33 (NASB) “But when the Son of Man comes in His glory, and all the angels with Him, then He will sit on His glorious throne. All the nations will be gathered before Him; and He will separate them from one another, as the shepherd separates the sheep from the goats; and He will put the sheep on His right, and the goats on the left.”

1. Judgement will happen when Jesus comes in His glory.
2. Jesus is the one that will do the judging.
3. Jesus knows each persons position.

**Second: Who will FACE Judgement?**

Hebrews 9:27 (NASB) “It is appointed for each man to die once and after this comes judgment.”

**Third: What will this judgment LOOK like?**

The GREAT WHITE THRONE judgement.

**Revelation 20:11-15 (NASB)**

2 Thessalonians 1:7b-10 (NASB) “The Lord Jesus will be revealed from heaven with His mighty angels in flaming fire, dealing out retribution to those who do not know God and to those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus. These will pay the penalty of eternal destruction, away from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His power, when He comes to be glorified in His saints on that day, and to be marveled at among all who have believed—for our testimony to you was believed.”

2 Corinthians 5:10 (NASB) “For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may be recompensed for his deeds in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad.”

1 Corinthians 3:12-15 (NASB) “Now if any man builds on the foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw, each man’s work will become evident; for the day will show it because it is to be revealed with fire, and the fire itself will test the quality of each man’s work. If any man’s work which he has built on it remains, he will receive a reward. If any man’s work is burned up, he will suffer loss; but he himself will be saved, yet so as through fire.”

#### 1. All who stand before the Bama have the same foundation.

1 Corinthians 3:10-11 (NASB) “According to the grace of God which was given to me, like a wise master builder I laid a foundation, and another is building on it. But each man must be careful how he builds on it. For no man can lay a foundation other than the one which is laid, which is Jesus Christ.”

#### 2. The materials you choose will be determine the quality of your work.

1 Corinthians 4:5 (NASB) “Do not go on passing judgment before the time, but wait until the Lord comes who will both bring to light the things hidden in the darkness and disclose the motives of men’s hearts; and then each man’s praise will come to him from God.”

#### 3. Each persons work will be judged.
